Dear Travel Soccer Families,

I just finished a highly productive meeting with a group of parents dedicated to the continuation and growth of travel soccer in Hoboken. Our shared objective is to provide our children with the best recreational opportunities, particularly within the realm of travel soccer. Following a discussion that touched on several options, the parents decided to establish a new, 501(c)(3) organization, independent from the City, that will assume responsibility for travel soccer in Hoboken for the upcoming fall season. The parents have represented to me that this newly created organization will strongly resemble what you were used to, and that the final details about this program will be released in the near future. I want to be clear that I fully support this initiative.

As a result of the very positive outcome of this meeting, the City will not issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) at this time. It is my preference to work with Hoboken parents and families forming this new organization to continue a Hoboken travel soccer program this fall.
