Subject: James Solomon, with Momentum, Leads in New Poll for Jersey City Mayor

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A new PPP poll in Jersey City finds James Solomon in the lead with 24%. Jim McGreevey is at 22% with 16% of respondents voting for Bill O'Dea and another 10% for Mussab Ali. 24% of respondents are still undecided.

Since PPP's last poll in June, McGreevey's image has taken a hit, with his net favorability dropping a net 14 points from +8 (38/30) over the summer to now -6 (30/36).

Looking toward a possible Solomon-McGreevey runoff McGreevey has a 15/39 favorability among people supporting one of the rest of the candidates while Solomon is at 20/16.

Among those who say they are certain to vote, Solomon leads with 26%, McGreevey at 21%, and O'Dea at 18%.

PPP interviewed 494 likely voters in Jersey City on October 20-21, 2025. The margin of error for the poll is +/- 4.4%. 88% of interviews were conducted by text and 12% by landline.
